House Bill 336 (Delegate Grosfeld, et al.) Judiciary

Domestic Violence - Temporary Ex Parte Orders and Protective Orders - Available Relief - Surrender of Firearms

This bill authorizes temporary ex parte and protective orders to include an order to surrender any owned or possessed firearms. When serving such an order, law enforcement officers are required to search for and seize any firearms until further order of the court.
