**Financial Institutions - Subpoenas**

---

This bill authorizes a fiduciary institution to recover costs incurred in complying with subpoenas issued in a civil action in which the fiduciary institution is not a party. These costs must be covered by the party seeking disclosure or production of records or information. The fiduciary institution must provide an invoice for the costs which identifies the services performed and the charge for each service.
