FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 866 (Frederick County Delegation) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Frederick County -Lamar Sanitarium - Historic Museum (\$100,000)

This bill provides \$100,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Central Maryland Heritage League, Inc. for the acquisition and renovation of Dr. Lamar's Sanitarium, a historic landmark located in Frederick County, for use as a historical museum with associated offices.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998, and must also grant a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$100,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
