Milk Products - Sell-By Period

This amended bill eliminates the authority of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish sell-by periods for Grade A milk products. The current law sell-by period is extended from 7 to 14 days. The current law authority of DHMH over sell-by markings on milk product containers is not altered.

The bill is effective June 1, 1996.
