Kent County - Gaming - Regulation

This amended bill makes procedural and stylistic changes to the law governing the regulation of gaming, other than slot machines, in Kent County. The County Commissioners are required to charge a fee for permits required for raffles or gaming device fund-raisers in the county. Charitable gaming activities may not benefit any political club or party, law enforcement agency, or State agency, except for schools and ambulance, firefighting, and rescue squads.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Negligible. The changes are primarily procedural or stylistic in nature. Any fee charged under this bill would be nominal, and would not affect county finances.
