## **Kent County - Gaming - Regulation**

This amended bill makes procedural and stylistic changes to the law governing the regulation of gaming, other than slot machines, in Kent County. The County Commissioners are required to charge a fee for permits required for raffles or gaming device fund-raisers in the county. Charitable gaming activities may not benefit any political club or party, law enforcement agency, or State agency, except for schools and ambulance, firefighting, and rescue squads.

**Local Effect:** Negligible. The changes are primarily procedural or stylistic in nature. Any fee charged under this bill would be nominal, and would not affect county finances.
