Senate Bill 86 (Senator Middleton)

**Vehicle Laws - Speeding Violations by Minors -  
Notification of Parent or Guardian**

This amended bill requires the District Court to notify the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) when a minor is charged with driving at least 20 miles per hour above the speed limit. In turn, the MVA is required to notify the minor's parent, guardian, or employer of the citation, whichever one cosigns the minor's driver's license application.

The bill also requires the MVA to report to the Senate Judicial Proceedings and House Commerce and Government Matters committees on implementation of this bill by November 1, 1996.

The bill is effective July 1, 1996, except that the MVA is not required to begin sending notification to parents, guardians, and employers until January 1, 1997.
