Task Force on Economic Growth and Development in Prince George's County

This amended bill establishes a nine-member Task Force on Economic Growth and Development in Prince George's County. The task force must formulate a strategic plan for the creation of greater opportunities for economic growth and development in Prince George's County after examining the issue. The Prince George's County government must provide staff for the task force; task force members are entitled to expense reimbursement to the extent funds are provided in the county budget. The task force must report its findings and recommendations to the Prince George's County Delegation to the Maryland General Assembly and the County Executive on or before July 1, 1997.

This bill is effective July 1, 1996 and sunsets July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Staff support for the task force can be provided by the Prince George's County government with existing budgeted resources. Expenditures could increase depending upon the amount of funds provided by Prince George's County for expense reimbursement. Any such increase is assumed to be minimal.
