Education - Course Requirements in the Public Schools

This enrolled bill requires the Maryland State Board of Education to review its rules and regulations to provide flexibility, for religious reasons, in meeting course requirements for graduation. The State Board must report its findings to the Legislative Policy Committee by October 1, 1997.

This bill takes effect October 1, 1996 and sunsets on September 30, 1997.
