Higher Education - Shortening Time to Degree

This resolution requests the Maryland Higher Education Commission to conduct a study of the time it takes to earn a degree at Maryland colleges and universities, including a review of possible incentives and strategies that could shorten the time to obtain a degree. It requests that the commission report to the Governor and General Assembly on its findings by December 31, 1996.
