House Bill 207 (Chairman, Commerce and Government Matters Committee) (Departmental - Transportation) Commerce and Government Matters

Height Limits on Structures and Vegetation - Adoption of Regulations -Baltimore-Washington International Airport

This departmental bill requires the Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA) to adopt regulations establishing maximum height limitations on structures and vegetation within a four mile radius of the Baltimore-Washington International Airport that are consistent with applicable federal aviation regulations. The bill repeals certain sections of current law that specify such limits.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The adoption of regulations required by this bill can be performed within the existing resources of the MAA without the need for additional expenditures.

Local Effect: None.
