House Bill 217 (Allegany County Delegation)
Judiciary

Education - Students - Arrest for Reportable Offense

This bill requires law enforcement agencies to notify the local superintendent of schools when students are arrested for offenses involving controlled dangerous substances and alcoholic beverages. Under current law, such notifications are only required for offenses involving crimes of violence or weapons violations.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Requiring State law enforcement agencies to notify local school officials of a student's arrest could be handled with existing resources.

Local Effect: None. Requiring that local school officials be notified of students committing offenses involving controlled dangerous substances and alcoholic beverages should not affect local finances.
