Commerce and Government Matters

State Information Technology Board - Membership

This departmental bill increases the membership of the State Information Technology Board from 21 to 22 by adding the Secretary of the Department of State Police (or his/her designee) as an ex officio member.

This bill is effective July 1, 1996.
