**Department of State Police - Enforcement of Motor Vehicle Laws in
Baltimore City**

This amended bill provides that the Department of State Police may enforce the State's motor vehicle laws in Baltimore City when requested to do so by the Mayor or Chief of Police of the city.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: It is anticipated that the State Police could exercise its motor vehicle law enforcement authority in Baltimore City with existing resources. However, any expansion of enforcement activities leading to additional costs would depend on the scale of involvement and would have to be justified through the normal State budgeting process.

Local Effect: None. Baltimore City revenues and expenditures would not be directly affected.
