Emergency Medical Services - Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council

This departmental bill alters the membership of the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council by adding a member who is a representative of the Committee on Pediatric Emergency Medicine of the Maryland Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1996.
