House Bill 1097 (Delegate Elliott) Judiciary

Child Protection - Reasonable Punishment by Parent

This bill adds to the definition of "abuse" as it relates to child abuse and neglect. Reasonable punishment, including corporal punishment administered by a parent or stepparent, is not considered abuse as long as it does not physically or mentally injure the child under circumstances indicating harm or threatened harm to the child.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill clarifies current law and is not expected to increase or decrease child abuse investigations or hearings.
