Rules and Executive Nominations

Committee to Review the Impact of the Federal Balanced Budget Amendment

This joint resolution requests the Speaker of the House of Delegates and the President of the Senate to appoint a Committee to Review the Impact of the Federal Balanced Budget Amendment on the State. The committee is to review the impact, including the direct and indirect impacts on the economy and on the budgets and programs of the State and local jurisdictions. The committee is to be composed of members of both houses of the General Assembly. The appropriate legislative and executive branch agencies are to provide the necessary support to the committee.

The committee must report its findings to the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly by December 15, 1996.
