This amended departmental bill provides for the disclosure of confidential social service records to: (1) out-of-state government officials; (2) local or State child care licensing and regulation officials; (3) directors of licensed child care facilities or placement agencies; and (4) individuals with an order from an Administrative Law Judge.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Disclosure of confidential records to certain entities would not have a direct impact on State finances; however, it could reduce the number of court orders requesting the disclosure of confidential records.

Local Effect: None.
