House Bill 338 (Delegate Donoghue, et al.) Economic Matters

## Utilization Review of Hospital Services - Minimum Length of Stay - Cesarean Section

This bill provides that the standards used by a private review agent or health maintenance organization (HMO) in performing utilization review with regard to length of hospital stay for maternity and newborn care services following a cesarean section must be in accordance with the medical criteria in the "Guidelines for Perinatal Care." A private review agent or HMO is prohibited from authorizing a shorter hospital length of stay based on the newborn's health status or by authorizing home visits.
