House Bill 408 (Delegate Harkins, et al.)

Referred to Judicial Proceedings

Volunteer Fire Company Officers - Emergency Equipment on Private Vehicles

This amended bill authorizes officers ranking second in command to the fire chief and the emergency medical services commander to have their privately owned vehicles equipped with red lights or signal devices. The bill provides that a maximum of five officers from each volunteer fire company may equip their private vehicles with red lights or signal devices.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Revenues and expenditures would not be affected assuming that the State does not finance the cost of installing such equipment.

Local Effect: None. Revenues and expenditures would not be affected assuming that the local governments do not finance the cost of installing such equipment.
