House Bill 498 (Delegate Curran) Commerce and Government Matters

## Election Law - Filing Campaign Fund-Raising Reports - Exception for Ticket Purchases

This bill allows a candidate to purchase up to two tickets to another candidate's campaign fund-raising event without triggering the requirement to file a campaign fund-raising report provided the candidate does not receive contributions or make other expenditures in excess of the \$300 contribution and expenditure reporting threshold. Under current law, if a candidate receives contributions or makes expenditures of \$300 or more, the candidate and the candidate's treasurer must file certain campaign fund-raising reports.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Any decrease in the number of reports filed with the State Administrative Board of Election Laws would be minimal. Accordingly, State finances would not be directly affected.

**Local Effect:** None. Any decrease in the number of reports filed with local elections boards would be minimal. Accordingly, county finances would not be directly affected.
