House Bill 1158 (Washington County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Sales to Minors and Intoxicated Persons)

This bill specifies that in Washington County the entering of a certain disposition in the criminal prosecution of a licensee or employee of a licensee for an alleged sale of alcoholic beverages to a minor or intoxicated person does not bar the Board of License Commissioners from proceeding administratively against the licensee.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: If the Board of License Commissioners proceeds administratively against a licensee, Washington County revenues could increase by an indeterminate, minimal amount due to additional fine revenues. Any costs associated with administrative proceedings could be handled with existing resources.
