House Bill 1288 (Delegate Gordon, et al.) Ways and Means Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Education - School Buses - Charging of Fees Prohibited

This amended bill prohibits local governments from charging a fee for transporting public school students to and from school.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Currently, no local government charges a fee to transport students to and from school.

Fiscal Analysis

Additional Comments: No local government currently charges a fee to transport students to and from public schools. It is not clear whether charging students a fee violates the State's constitution guarantee of a free and appropriate public education. However, if such fees are constitutional, this bill could reduce local revenues in the future if local boards of education want to implement such fees. Exhibit 1 shows the cost and number of students receiving school transportation services in fiscal 1994.
