Tort Reform - Reporting Requirements

This bill extends the reporting requirements for insurers providing professional liability coverage to health care providers. The Insurance Commissioner must continue to supply the Legislative Policy Committee with information on the availability and affordability of health care liability insurance and must include information related to the impact of the 1994 tort reform placing limits on noneconomic damages. The bill extends the sunset date from October 31, 1996 to October 31, 2001.
