Senate Bill 658 (Senator Haines) (Carroll County Delegation) Economic and Environmental Affairs

Carroll County - Nonprofit Entities - Procurement Contracts

This bill allows the County Commissioners of Carroll County to authorize nonprofit entities that receive county funds, or are eligible to do so, to participate in county procurement contracts.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Potential indeterminate decrease in expenditures. Revenues would not be affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: To the extent that Carroll County receives lower prices through its procurement contracts than nonprofits could receive on their own, procurement prices for eligible nonprofits would decrease. These decreases in expenditures could potentially be realized as cost savings by the county if reduced costs to the nonprofits translate into lower budget requirements for nonprofits that receive funding from the county.
