State Board of Physician Quality Assurance - Disciplinary Actions

This enrolled bill allows the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance to enter into an agreement with a licensee for corrective action after a determination that deficiencies exist and patient safety is not an issue. The bill provides specified procedures relating to such corrective action agreements. In addition, the bill adds as a ground for discipline a willful false representation when seeking licensure or making any related application.
