FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

Senate Bill 768 (Senator Blount) Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Health Care for the Homeless (\$150,000)

This bill provides \$150,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Health Care for the Homeless, Inc. for the renovation and equipping of a building in Baltimore City that is used as a support center for the homeless, and at which various services, such as crisis intervention, are provided.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998. The funds may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$150,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
