Extradition - Bail - Exceptions

This enrolled departmental bill delays for 10 days the release on bail of a person who has been arrested in Maryland under a request for extradition from another state.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Fugitives from other states are unlikely to obtain bail under current law.

Local Effect: None. Fugitives from other states are unlikely to obtain bail under current law.
