House Bill 589 (Delegate Campbell)

Economic Matters

Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages
(Board of License Commissioners - Employees)

This amended bill requires that employees of the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners be in the classified civil service of Baltimore City. Accordingly, the board may only appoint and remove employees in accordance with laws governing civil service employees. The bill also provides that the board may not employ more than 18 permanent part-time inspectors.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Requiring the board's employees to be in the classified civil service of Baltimore City would not directly affect city finances. The board currently employs 18 permanent part-time inspectors.
