House Bill 629 (Delegate Hixson) Economic Matters

## Motor Vehicle Insurance - Cancellation of Policy or Premium Increase - Violation of Motor Vehicle Laws

This bill prohibits a motor vehicle insurer from canceling an insurance policy or increasing the policy premiums solely because the policyholder: (1) has been convicted of failing to stop or yield the right of way no more than once in a three-year period; and (2) the violation occurred when the policyholder was entering a highway from the policyholder's private road or driveway.
