FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 769 (Howard County Delegation)
Ways and Means

Howard County Board of Education - Compensation
Ho. Co. 2-96

This bill increases the salaries of the members of the Howard County Board of Education. The chairman's salary is increased from \$6,800 to \$10,000. The members' salaries are increased from \$6,000 to \$9,000.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Howard County expenditures would increase by \$16,360 annually beginning in FY 1997. Revenues would not be affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: The Howard County Board of Education has five members elected for six-year terms. This bill would increase Howard County expenditures by \$16,360 annually (\$15,200 in salaries and \$1,160 in social security taxes) beginning in fiscal 1997.
