House Bill 809 (Prince George's County Delegation)

Economic Matters Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages (Class B-RD Revitalization District Licenses) PG 313-96

This amended bill creates a Class B-RD liquor revitalization district license in Prince George's County. The license may only be issued to a restaurant in a revitalization area that has gross sales not exceeding \$150,000 annually and of which at least 80% are from the sale of food. The annual license fee is \$600.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County revenues would increase by \$600 for each Class B-RD license issued. Although the number of licenses to be issued cannot be determined beforehand, the revenue increase would be minimal. County expenditures would not be affected.
