## **Certificate of Merit - Licensed Professionals**

This bill requires a plaintiff to file a "certificate of a qualified expert" from certain licensed professionals before pursuing a malpractice claim against a person licensed in the same profession. This bill covers architects, interior designers, landscape architects, engineers, and land surveyors.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. This bill does not directly affect government operations or finances. **Local Effect:** None. While the bill has the potential to reduce the number of professional malpractice claims in the circuit courts, it is not expected to measurably affect court caseloads.
