## **Utility Regulation - Public Service Companies - Economic Fairness and Equal Access**

This bill provides that if a public service company makes available or sells specified "resources" to its nonregulated subsidiary, the company must charge its subsidiary the fair market value of the resource and make the resource available to any interested party for the same price.
