Graffiti - Punishments for Adults and Juveniles

This bill provides that an adult convicted of an act of graffiti may be ordered to pay restitution or perform community service. If a juvenile commits an act of graffiti, the juvenile's driver's license must be suspended and the juvenile may be ordered to perform community service instead of paying restitution.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Since it is assumed this bill would apply in a limited number of cases there was only one conviction in 1995 - State finances would not be affected.

Local Effect: None. Since it is assumed this bill would apply in a limited number of cases, local finances would not be affected.
