House Bill 1299 (Harford County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Alcoholic Beverages - Harford County
(Alcohol Awareness Training)

This bill requires that alcoholic beverages licensees or supervisory employees in Harford County be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program. These individuals must also be present when alcohol is sold. Violators are subject to a fine of \$100 for a first offense and, for each subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$500 and/or a suspension or revocation of a license.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Harford County revenues could increase by an indeterminate, minimal amount due to the penalty provision. Enforcement could be handled with existing resources.
