Education - Educational Assistants and Paraprofessional Employees

This enrolled bill establishes a 24-member Task Force on Educational Assistants and Paraprofessionals in the Public Schools of Maryland. The task force is required to review the present utilization of educational assistants and paraprofessionals by the local boards of education. The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) is required to provide staff support. The task force's recommendations are due to the General Assembly by December 15, 1996.

The bill takes effect June 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Any expense reimbursements for task force members and staffing costs for MSDE are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing resources. Revenues would not be affected.
