House Bill 1449 (Delegate Bissett)
Rules and Executive Nominations

Civil Actions - Punitive Damages

This bill defines punitive damages and specifies the circumstances in which they may be awarded. In addition, the bill provides that a court must give instructions to a jury regarding the purpose of punitive damages and other factors to consider in making such an award. Finally, the bill provides that either trial or appellate courts must review awards of punitive damages to assure that the awards are supported by clear and convincing evidence in the record and are consistent with the principles and factors applicable under Maryland law.

The bill applies prospectively.
