**Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages**  
**(Local Hours and Days for Sale)**

---

This bill authorizes the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners, by regulation, to restrict the hours and days for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in a specified section of the city. This section includes the area bounded by 31st Street on the south, Greenmount Avenue on the east, 32nd Street on the north, and Barclay Street on the west.

The bill is effective June 1, 1996.

**Fiscal Summary**

**Local Effect:** None. Baltimore City could enforce the bill's restrictions with existing resources. Revenues would not be directly affected.
