Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund - Placement Charge

This bill increases the maximum charge allowed by agents or brokers from \$10 to \$20 for the placement of automobile insurance through the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund.

Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund (MAIF): Increasing the placement fee would not

directly affect MAIF's finances.

Fiscal Analysis

Additional Comments: By increasing the placement fee from \$10 to \$20 that agents and brokers may charge for handling each MAIF policy, and assuming a continuance of 187,000 applications per year, an additional \$1,870,000 would be paid to these producers each year. These transactions are handled directly between the applicant and the agent or broker.
