FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

Senate Bill 789 (Senator Della) Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Project Liberty Ship (\$330,000)

This bill provides \$330,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Project Liberty Ship for the renovation and preservation, including replacement of the rivets, of the historic Liberty Ship, John W. Brown, which is used as a memorial to merchant marines and naval armed guards.

The Project Liberty Ship must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998, and must also grant a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$330,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
