AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 240

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after "State;" insert "making a separate offense of bringing into the State a certain amount of marijuana under certain circumstances; providing certain penalties:".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 15, after "(a)" insert "(1)"; in line 17, strike "subsection (b)" and substitute "SUBSECTION (B)(1)"; and in line 18, strike "10 pounds" and substitute "45 KILOGRAMS".

On page 1, in lines 18, 19, 21, 23, 25, and 27 and on page 2, in lines 1 and 3, strike "(1)", "(2)", "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", "(7)", and "(8)", respectively, and substitute "(I)", "(II)", "(III)", "(IV)", "(V)", "(VI)", "(VII)", and "(VIII)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 3, insert:

"(2) A PERSON WHO BRINGS INTO THIS STATE MARIJUANA IN THE AMOUNT OF MORE THAN 5 KILOGRAMS BUT LESS THAN 45 KILOGRAMS WHICH IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR THAT PERSON TO POSSESS IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTY PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION.";

in line 4, after "(b)" insert "(1)"; in the same line, strike "subsection (a)" and substitute "SUBSECTION (A)(1)"; and after line 6, insert:

"(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS OR BOTH."
