AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Civil" and substitute "<u>District</u>"; in line 3, strike "District and circuit courts" and substitute "<u>Chief Judge of the District Court</u>"; in line 4, after "collected;" insert "<u>establishing the Maryland Legal Services Corporation Fund;</u>"; in line 6, after "Corporation" insert "<u>Fund</u>"; in line 7, after the first semicolon insert "<u>providing for the appropriation of moneys</u> collected under this Act;".

On page 1, in line 11, strike "7-202 and".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 3, after line 15, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) In this section, "Fund" means the Maryland Legal Services Corporation Fund.
- (b) In Fiscal Year 1998, moneys derived from the surcharge assessed in civil cases under § 7-301 of the Courts Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall be transferred to the Fund.
- (c) The Fund is a nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (d) Expenditures from the Fund shall be made pursuant to an appropriation approved by the General Assembly in the annual State budget or by the budget amendment procedure provided for in § 7-209 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (e) The moneys distributed to the Fund shall be used by the Maryland Legal Services Corporation to fund civil legal services to indigents as provided by Article 10, § § 45A through 45Q of the Code.";

and in line 16, strike "2." and substitute "3.".

AMENDMENT NO. 8

On page 3, in line 17, strike the first "June" and substitute "July".
