AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 400

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “checks;” insert “requiring certain preconditions to be satisfied before an individual may begin work for a certain dealer as an employee;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 6, strike “\$275” and substitute “\$75”; strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive, and substitute “BEFORE AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BEGIN WORK FOR A DEALER AS AN EMPLOYEE:

(1) THE DEALER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY, ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY PROVIDES, THE NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL; AND

(2) THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL APPLY FOR A NATIONAL AND STATE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK REQUIRED UNDER § 12-204(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.”;

strike beginning with “INDIVIDUALS” in line 26 down through “REPOSITORY” in line 30 and substitute “APPLICANTS FOR LICENSES UNDER § 12-201 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND INDIVIDUALS WHOSE NAMES MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY UNDER § 12-203 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL APPLY TO THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY FOR A NATIONAL AND STATE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK ON A FORM APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY”.

On page 3, in line 22, after “DEALER” insert “OR AN APPLICANT”; in line 29, strike “(G)(1)” and substitute “PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION”; and in line 30, after “DEALER” insert “OR AN APPLICANT”.

On page 4, in line 15, strike “\$275” and substitute “\$75”.
