AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 670

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “indication;” insert “requiring the placement of certain warning signs at each intersection monitored by an active traffic control signal monitoring system;”; and in line 18, before “and” insert “providing that during certain periods this Act may be enforced only with a warning; requiring certain law enforcement agencies to undertake certain public education activities during certain periods;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 34, after “(B)” insert “(1)”; and after line 36, insert:

“(2) (I) THE APPROPRIATE AGENCY SHALL PLACE OR CAUSE TO BE PLACED, AT EACH INTERSECTION MONITORED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM, WARNING SIGNS NOTIFYING MOTORISTS APPROACHING THE INTERSECTION THAT THE INTERSECTION IS BEING MONITORED.

(II) THE SIGNS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH MAY BE PLACED ONLY AT AN INTERSECTION WITH AN ACTIVE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 10, after line 22, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, during the first 60 days after a traffic control signal monitoring system is installed at an intersection, the law enforcement agency responsible for traffic control at the intersection:

(a) may enforce this Act only through the issuance of warnings in lieu of citations;

(Over)

and

(b) shall undertake a public education campaign utilizing the local media and public meetings with citizens groups, schools, and businesses in the vicinity of the intersection to notify the public of the placement of the traffic control signal monitoring system and the provisions of this Act.”;

and in line 23, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
