AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike "separate"; in line 5, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>requiring the</u> <u>clerk to make and maintain a certain separate record when an expungement order is presented in</u> <u>certain cases;</u>"; and in the same line, after "record;" insert "<u>limiting the availability of the record;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 6, strike "SEPARATE"; in line 7, after "REFUSAL" insert ", INCLUDING THE NAME OF THE SPOUSE REFUSING TO TESTIFY"; in line 8, strike "THE RECORD SHALL INCLUDE" and substitute "<u>WHEN AN EXPUNGEMENT ORDER IS</u> <u>PRESENTED TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT IN A CASE INVOLVING A CHARGE OF</u> <u>ASSAULT IN ANY DEGREE, THE CLERK SHALL CHECK THE RECORD TO DETERMINE</u> <u>WHETHER THE DEFENDANT'S SPOUSE REFUSED TO TESTIFY ON THE BASIS OF THE</u> <u>PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.</u>

(3) IF THE RECORD SHOWS SUCH A REFUSAL, THE CLERK SHALL MAKE AND MAINTAIN A SEPARATE RECORD OF THE REFUSAL, INCLUDING";

in line 11, strike "(3)" and substitute "(4)"; in the same line, after "THE" insert "<u>SEPARATE</u>"; in the same line, after "RECORD" insert "<u>SPECIFIED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS</u> <u>SUBSECTION:</u>

<u>(I)</u>";

and in line 12, after "CODE" insert "; AND

(II) SHALL BE AVAILABLE ONLY TO THE COURT, A STATE'S ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AND AN ATTORNEY FOR THE DEFENDANT".
