AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 701

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before “Program” insert “Pilot”; in the same line, strike “Continuation” and substitute “Repeal of Termination Provision”; in line 6, before “Program” insert “Pilot”; in the same line, strike “the provisions” and substitute “a certain obsolete provision”; in the same line, after “law” insert “; repealing a certain provision of law”; in line 7, after the first “the” insert “evaluation and”; in the same line, before “Program” insert “Pilot”; in line 8, strike “providing for the effective date of this Act;” and substitute “altering the name of the School Health Pilot Program; making a stylistic change;”; in line 9, strike “continuation” and substitute “repeal”; in the same line, after “the” insert “termination provision relating to the”; and in the same line, before “Program” insert “Pilot”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 19, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - State Government

Section 8-403(b)(9), (10), and (11)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 8, strike “a”; in the same line, strike “REPORT” and substitute “REPORTS”; in line 27, strike “and”; and in line 29, after “care” insert “; AND”

(III) TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING HEALTH AND REFERRAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS:

(Over)

1. FIRST AID;

2. PHYSICAL EXAMS AND SPORTS PHYSICALS;

3. CARE FOR MINOR AND CHRONIC ILLNESSES;

4. IMMUNIZATIONS;

5. PREVENTIVE HEALTH EDUCATION SERVICES;

6. REFERRALS FOR COUNSELING AT THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT; AND

7. SOCIAL SERVICES REFERRALS”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, in line 8, strike “2000” and substitute “2001”; after line 15, insert:

“[7-418.

The provisions of this subtitle creating the School Health Pilot Program and relating to the regulation of this Program and any regulations promulgated under the Program are of no effect and may not be enforced after July 1, 1997.]

Article - State Government

8-403.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e) of this section, on or before July 1, 1991, an evaluation shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

(9) Real Estate Hearing Board (§ 17-325 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article); AND

(10) Division of Savings and Loan Associations (§ 8-301 of the Financial Institutions Article) [; and

(11) School Health Pilot Program (§ 7-415 of the Education Article)].”.
