AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1181

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 13, after “date;” insert “providing for the abrogation of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 2, after “Students” insert “- Pilot”.

On page 2, in line 20, after “(I)” insert “1.”; and in line 21, after “YEARS” insert “; OR

2. REACHES THE AGE OF 23 YEARS WHILE PARTICIPATING
IN AN APPROVED PAID WORK-BASED LEARNING PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 3, strike “2002” and substitute “1999”; in line 6, after “(2)” insert “(I)”; and after line 8, insert:

“(II) THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE PAID WORK-BASED LEARNING
PROGRAM STUDENTS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT EXCEED 100 FOR
EACH TAXABLE YEAR.”.

On page 5, in line 2, strike “2001” and substitute “1999”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, after line 2, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall remain effective for a
period of 2 years and 9 months and, at the end of June 30, 2000, with no further action required by
the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. “;

and in line 3, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.
