AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 111

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike “clarifying” and substitute “providing”; in line 4, after “suspended;” insert “altering the circumstances for a termination or suspension;”; in line 6, after the semicolon insert “requiring the Governor, Secretary of State, or Assistant Secretary of State to send a certain notice to the Secretary of the State Police; allowing the Secretary of the State Police to suspend or revoke a handgun permit of a special police officer under certain circumstances;”; and strike beginning with “the” in line 8 down through “neutral” in line 9 and substitute “stylistic changes”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 15, strike “(C)”, and substitute “(D)”; in line 18, after “appointment,” insert “OR ITS SUCCESSOR ENTITY,”; in line 32, after “(B)” insert “(1)”; after line 34, insert:

“(2) THE GOVERNOR, SECRETARY OF STATE, OR ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE WHO EXERCISES THE POWER TO TERMINATE OR SUSPEND A COMMISSION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL IMMEDIATELY SEND NOTICE OF THE TERMINATION OR SUSPENSION TO THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE POLICE.

“(C) THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE POLICE MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A HANDGUN PERMIT OF A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER WHOSE COMMISSION IS TERMINATED OR SUSPENDED UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE HANDGUN PERMIT WAS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH THE DUTIES OF THE SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER.”;

and in line 35, strike “(C)” and substitute “(D)”.
