AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 781

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Senator Bromwell” and substitute “Senators Bromwell and Derr”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 9, after “Benefits;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 32, insert:

“(I) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

“(II) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;”;

in lines 33, 35, and 37, strike “(I)”, “(II)”, and “(III)”, respectively, and substitute “(III)”, “(IV)”, and “(V)”, respectively; and after line 38, insert:

“(VI) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM COPPIN STATE COLLEGE SCHOOL OF NURSING, APPOINTED BY THE DEAN;

“(VII) SEVEN NONPHYSICIAN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO WHOM HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT AS A MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

“(VIII) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL

(Over)

FACULTY OF MARYLAND;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, in lines 1, 3, 7, 9, 11, and 13, strike “(IV)”, “(V)”, “(VII)”, “(VIII)”, “(IX)”, and “(X)”, respectively, and substitute “(IX)”, “(X)”, “(XII)”, “(XIII)”, “(XIV)”, and “(XV)”, respectively; strike in their entirety lines 5 and 6, and substitute:

“(XI) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN;”;

in line 15, strike “ADVISORY PANEL” and substitute “GOVERNOR”; in line 16, strike “ITS MEMBERS” and substitute “THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY PANEL”; in line 20, after “ALL” insert “CURRENT AND PROPOSED”; strike beginning with “DETERMINING” in line 21 down through “REPEALED” in line 23 and substitute “EVALUATING THEIR COST EFFECTIVENESS AND MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO CONTINUING, MODIFYING, OR REPEALING CURRENT MANDATES AND APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING PROPOSED MANDATES”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 4, in line 8, strike “AND EACH DECEMBER 1 THEREAFTER,”; in line 21, strike “October” and substitute “July”; in the same line, after “1997.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 1999, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
